Nethaji Youth Group was promoted with the support of ChildFund India in the year of 2014. The youth group members are pursuing their education and slowly engaging in civic activities. From starting they are conducting monthly meetings meanwhile they came forward to address the issues prevailing in their villages i.e. plantation, swatch bharaath activities, sanitation, etc., Later, they came forward to manage Youth Resource Centres on their own and meanwhile addressing child rights violations in their villages. Those are child marriages, school dropouts, management of safe drinking water and also extended support to overcome the problems at school level.

Sanction of pucca road to Eguva Palli village from K. Brahmana Palli (3.5 Kms.)

Eguva Palli is a remote village. There is no public transportation facility between Eguva Palli to Brahmana Palli villages. Only way is to walk / come by bicycle / two-wheeler. Autos are also not running in between between the villages. Students, Adolescent girls and youth about 20 members are attending to high schools / colleges. The road is drastically damaged and difficult to pass during rainy season. Parents of adolescent girls are afraid on their children safety and security in-turn discontinuing education of the girls. The sides of road are covered with bushes and during evening hours, it is horrible to pass through the road. In view of the above situation Nethaji Youth Group Members conducted Dharna for 5 days. Other Youth Group Members and political leaders and village elders shared their solidarity to the Dharna. Officials, Police, MPDO, MRO and other political leaders visited the Dharna spot and assured to sanction pucca road.
